

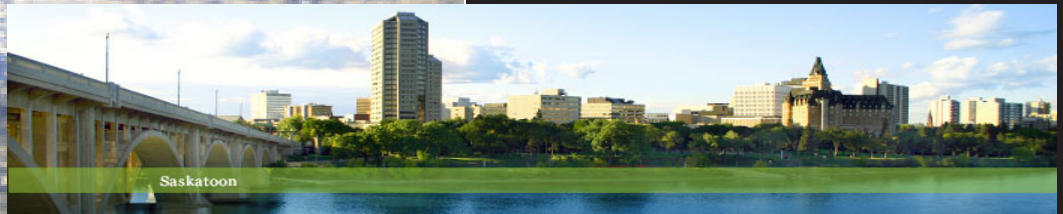

Who is Grace Fellowship?

Grace Fellowship is a Christian community which exists for the glory of God and the good of the city by extending hope through the gospel and grace of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Saskatoon is situated along the banks of the scenic South Saskatchewan River in the heart of the Canadian prairies. Saskatoon is desperately in need of churches that proclaim a God-centered gospel. It is our province's largest city with a population of approximately 1/4 million people (one fourth of the province's population), and it is growing. Where I grew up in rural Saskatchewan, there is town after town without any Bible believing church at all. It seems to me that Saskatoon, which is centrally located in our province, would be the strategic center from which to begin to impact our community and from there continue to diffuse the fragrance of the knowledge of God in the face of Jesus Christ for the glory of the triune God.



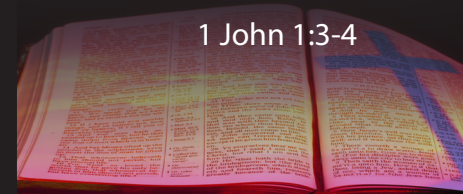

Our Missional Strategy for Church planting in Saskatoon

Do all to the glory of God-

Our desire is to have God at the center of all that we do, seeking His glory first and foremost (1 Cor. 10:31).

It's all about Jesus-

My number one goal would be to teach the Bible that we might learn about Jesus! I desire that Jesus be the center and the circumference of all we do. He is the centerpiece of God's gift and revelation to us. The essence of worship is valuing Christ more than all the world has to offer.

Without Me you can do nothing-

As one who is totally dependent upon the Lord - the builder of the house - prayer is of utmost importance.

Go therefore and make disciples-

We seek to freely offer Jesus Christ to all as the joyful news to be received "without money and without price" (Isa.55:1). We earnestly exhort all to look away from themselves and embrace Christ, who died the sinner's death on the cross, for the forgiveness of sin and the satisfaction of the soul. We have no goal to reach a specific sub-group, but rather are open to all the Lord brings across our path. We want Jesus to build His church, and as such we desire to preach the gospel to every creature. Our church must value the privilege God has given all of us as being His ambassadors, accomplishing His goal of spreading the knowledge of His glory to our community and beyond.

Feed My sheep-

The faithful exposition of the Christ-centered Scriptures needs to be the focus of our assembly time. The Scripture is God's reliable, authoritative, and sufficient revelation. Through the Word, sinners are saved and saints built up. I love the full revelation of God's dealings in the Bible with its unfolding gospel of Christ culminating in His glorious life, death, resurrection, and ascension as King of kings and Lord of lords.

Train up faithful men-

One of our goals will be to look for and train up potential leaders. We want to be equipping gifted servants of Christ to see that the mission of Christ is carried on in the way God has instructed in His Word.

A new commandment I give unto you-

We desire that our enjoyment of Christ's gracious riches overflow in love that meets the needs of others. Thus we aim to strengthen each others' faith in hard times, restore hurt relationships, comfort the broken-hearted, and implore prodigals to return to the Father.

We value building up strong marriages and families, where God's Word is taught and lived out; where husbands love their wives as Christ loved the church; where wives respect their husbands; where the hearts of the parents are turned toward their children and the hearts of the children toward their parents.

We value the diversity that God created among mankind and the unity in diversity that God creates among His people - a unity that manifests itself beyond Christian politeness and friendliness, in an authentic community showing love, care, and concern throughout the week as we share our lives with each other. Through every believer using their gifts for the benefit and growth of one another, we desire to help one another fix our eyes on our Lord Jesus Christ to increase our love and enjoyment of Him to the glory of God.

I am delighted to see what the Lord will unfold. Life is an adventure, and our Lord has written the script. That knowledge gives me great hope and faith. ACTS 29 NETWORK

Grace Fellowship is associated with the Acts 29 church-planting network. The Acts 29 Network exists to start churches that plant churches - thus continuing Christ's mission as revealed in the first 28 chapters of Acts; hence the name, Acts 29. God is significantly using this network to influence and shape the church planting culture

through both rock-solid theology and contextualizing the gospel. Acts 29 churches won't water down their theology to reach more people, and they won't attack the culture in the name of Christianity. The goal of Acts 29 is to plant churches that are missionaries in their respective communities sent by Christ with the gospel (John 20:21).

Our Gospel Identity

It is my hope that Grace Fellowship will be a gospel-centered church that embraces the calling of God to act as a missionary to our culture. As we focus on our purpose, we do not first first ask the question, "What works best?" Instead, we ask, "How do we best display who God is and what He has done in and through Jesus Christ?" appropriately within the culture into which we are sent?

Because Jesus has drawn us into the love and fellowship enjoyed by the Triune God, we are eternally satisfied in Him. We have a new identity because of what He has accomplished for us and who we are in Christ.

We are His:

- **Family** - adopted children committed to the privilege of loving and caring for one another.
- **Missionaries** - ambassadors who have been reconciled and sent out to be agents of reconciliation.
- **Servants** - His purchased possession, following Jesus, the ultimate Servant, who humbly gave His life in joyful submission, even unto death, so that others could experience salvation, peace, and restoration.
- **Learners** - The church is a community of learners - called to equip and be equipped.

In this gospel identity we desire to live out the reality of being the church together as a family on mission sent by God to serve our world and continually learn how to walk in His ways.

How you can be involved

There is a tremendous need for gospel-centered churches that exalt the Sovereign God of heaven and earth in western Canada. Our desire is not simply to plant one church, but to begin a movement of churches which plant churches in Saskatchewan and the western provinces, beginning in the urban centers. This will take a ministry team. Pray that the Lord would raise up laborers to be sent into His harvest. If you know of individuals who are looking for such a ministry to support, perhaps you could mention us to them. If you know of gifted and godly men who might be interested in being involved in such a church planting ministry, we would love to connect with them.
